# Quick Tips and Resources



Often classroom teachers will have students practice sight words or high frequency words in class and/or at home. Many of these words come from the Dolch and Fry word lists that were developed based on the most frequently occurring words in the English language. It is recommended that by combining explicit phonics instruction with either the Dolch or Fry list words helps to create stronger reading fluency in students.

The dyslexia teachers at Dolores Huerta deliver explicit phonics instruction as well as pull words from the Fry lists to use and practice with students. Practicing these words in class and at home is a great way to help your student become a more fluent reader. You can find may fun ways to practice sight/high frequency words by visiting
