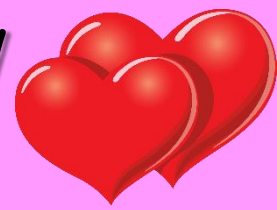

Primary School Level Reading Instruction

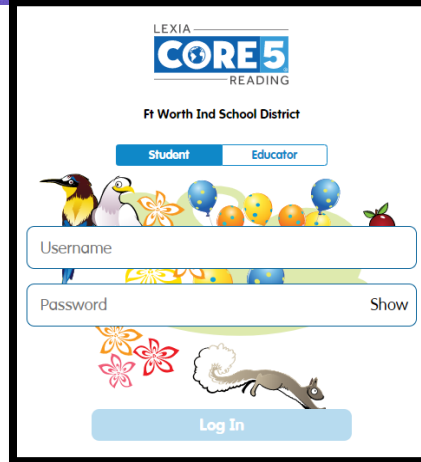
Welcome to Lexia Core 5!
